**Pre-entry (or early registration) is highly encouraged; Post-entries will be charged a 1 time fee of \$10 per horse and rider combination. There is no penalty if you pre-register and then scratch, so please pre-enter.**

**Office fee:** \$3 per horse and rider/handler team at each show.

**For Pleasure Shows:** Non-members will be charged a \$1.00 number fee  
(refundable at the end of the show if you return your number).

## N BAR H RIDING CLUB RULES AND REGULATIONS

All participants, including riders, handlers, and spectators, are responsible for a thorough knowledge of and compliance with these rules and policies, as well as those stated elsewhere in the show book and in the constitution and by-laws of the club.

### REGISTRATION

1. A negative Coggins report is required at registration for all horses – no horse should be unloaded on Club grounds before the negative Coggins report has been checked by show management. Reports for horses stabled in NH are good for 1 year; federal law dictates that all horses crossing a state line must have a negative coggins report within 6 months.

Please present a clear copy of your Coggins report for every horse at the time of your first registration and we will keep copies on file. No horse will be allowed to show and will be asked to leave if the paperwork is not available or if it does not match the horse. A rabies vaccination is not required, but is highly recommended.

2. Classes, including any add-on, must be paid for before the class begins. Pre-entries do not have to be paid for at the time of registration, but do need to be settled before the first entered class begins. An open check may be left at the secretary's booth and settled at the end of the day.
3. You may join and pay for membership the day of a show and receive membership rates for that show and any future 2011 shows.
4. Refunds may be given for any class scratched at least 2 classes in advance.
5. Pre-entries must be received by 8 PM the Wednesday before the scheduled show. Please feel free to enter for all four shows at the beginning of the year – you do not have to pay at the time of pre-registration and there is no penalty for scratching. Phone entries will not be accepted. Any entries received after this deadline or on the day of the show will be subject to the post-entry fees. Additions will be subject to the post-entry class fee. Additions must be paid before the class begins.
6. At Pleasure shows, all additions must be made at least 2 classes in advance. Any rider/handler in a class who is not registered may be asked to exit the ring not be judged in that class. Please plan accordingly to ensure you have time to come to the booth and make the addition appropriately – simply yelling your change into the secretary's booth is not acceptable.
7. New members are eligible for benefits the day they become members, including reduced class fees and accumulated year-end points. However, membership is not retroactive and all points earned before becoming a member will not count towards year-end awards or eligibility.
8. In the event a check is returned for insufficient funds, N Bar H will charge a \$20 fee and the privilege of paying by check may be revoked and points accrued may be rescinded.
9. Entry forms must have the complete name and address of the rider/handler.
10. Any rider or handler who wishes to be considered for a breed, color, barn, or age specific award must put the required information on their entry forms; the VPs cannot guess and will not research this information.
11. Age of rider is that as of January 1st of the show year; exhibitors MUST enter age division accordingly; extenuating circumstances may be discussed with show management.
12. A horse may be entered only once in each class regardless of rider. However, a horse may enter two classes with the same pattern in different age divisions with different riders.  
For example: if Junior rides Tonto in Barrels Jr., Dad can ride Tonto in Barrels Sr. However, if Junior rides Tonto in Barrels Jr., Sissy may not ride Tonto in Barrels Jr.

13. A horse and rider/handler may only enter one division per show; cross-entry is not allowed.
  - a) Well-schooled horses may be used in multiple divisions, such as leadline, walk/trot and walk/trot/canter as long as the horse is not unduly fatigued.
  - b) An experienced rider may ride a green horse in walk/trot and a seasoned horse in walk/trot/canter.
  - c) Green horses and beginner riders may only enter one division regardless of changes in rider or mount (i.e., a green horse may not go in both walk/trot and Green Horse and a beginner rider may not go in both walk/trot and Beginner Rider or walk/trot/canter).
  - d) The same rule applies to Gymkhana – a horse and rider may compete either in their age division OR Novice rider/Green Horse or Masters – not both.
14. Green horses are allowed in walk/trot classes. However, green horses must be ridden by non-beginner riders, and must be thoroughly under the control due to the presence of beginner riders in the ring at the same time.
15. Please be considerate of those working in the secretary's booth; it isn't always the same person and they don't always know you or your horse. Be consistent with your horse's name (i.e., if your horse is named Giant Gentle Ben, do not enter him in one show as Giant, one as Ben and one as Gentle Ben). In order to ensure that you receive all the appropriate end-year points, you must be consistent. Mind you, it is fine to use a shortened name or nickname/barn name as long as you use it consistently.
16. Each entry is based on one rider/horse combination. That is, if members are lucky enough to have two horses or a few kids showing, one needs to fill out entirely separate entry forms, pay separate Office fees (that's the \$3 fee mentioned earlier) and get unique numbers if applicable.

Example: Junior and Tonto: #100

Junior and Spot: #300

Sissy and Tonto: #200

Sissy and Spot: #400

*Hint: Write each pair's names on the back of their number so they do not get confused. You MUST keep your number from one show to the next within the series. If something does happen and you need a replacement number, there will be a charge.*

## **YEAR-END POINTS**

17. Year-end points will be determined using the following system regardless of the number of entries in the class:
 

1 <sup>st</sup> place = 6 points	2 <sup>nd</sup> place = 5 points	3 <sup>rd</sup> place = 4 points
4 <sup>th</sup> place = 3 points	5 <sup>th</sup> place = 2 points	6 <sup>th</sup> place = 1 point
18. Only members are eligible for year-end points and a horse/rider or horse/handler team must enter in at least 3 of a series' four shows and must compete in each class three of four times to qualify for points in any particular class.
19. To qualify for points, a horse, pony, or miniature horse must be handled or ridden by the same person and that team must remain in the same division for three of the four shows.
20. Year-end points accumulate over all four shows, so it is in the best interest of the horse/rider or horse/handler team to come to all four shows and show in the same classes.

## SHOW MANAGEMENT AND JUDGING

21. No person shall approach the judge regarding a decision or other matter unless they first obtain permission from show management. Any exhibitor violating this rule will be asked to leave and will forfeit all fees. Judges will be asked to respect competitors by not approaching them except for brief schooling comments immediately at the end of the class.
22. Show management reserves the right to change judges, decline an entry, or vary or cancel any class.
23. Any class may be divided at the judge's discretion; very small classes may be combined, but each competitor will be asked and allowed to veto the combination. Year-end awards will be maintained for the separate classes.

Exceptions:

- a. Miniature Horse Driving classes may be divided if entries exceed 12, for safety, as the ring cannot safely accommodate more than 12 entries. Show management will determine how (i.e., by "A" and "B" size or Youth and Adult, etc.). If this is necessary, year-end points will be given to each group.
  - b. Miniature Horse "B" division Halter class is currently stallions, mares, and geldings combined. If the class has enough entries to have a minimum of three in each category, the class will be divided by each sex separately or by stallion/geldings combined and mares shown separately.
24. Gymkhana management reserves the right to disallow a competitor if he/she does not seem to have control of his/her horse for the safety of all present.

## GENERAL SHOW RULES

25. ABSOLUTELY NO ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES ON THE SHOW GROUNDS AT ANY TIME.
26. An adult must accompany small children at all times and is responsible for not just the child's safety, but also that of the horses and handlers a child may frighten or disturb.
27. All dogs must be tied, in a car with the windows down, or on a leash at all times for the safety of the dog, horses, handlers, and the general public.
28. No rider/handler shall do more than a brisk walk on the grounds except in the warm-up area.
29. The show ring is closed to warming up except at the lunch break. Riders may use the back ring to warm up whenever as long as it is not being used for a class.
30. Riders/handlers aged 16 years and older may handle a stallion in individual classes in a closed ring. The stallion must be under the exclusive control of an adult 18 years or older at all times outside the ring and before and after the gate is closed. Any rider/handler showing a stallion in a group class must be 18 years or older. The first violation to this rule as determined by the show management will result in immediate expulsion of the stallion from the show grounds for the rest of the year.

**STALLIONS MUST WEAR A VISIBLE YELLOW RIBBON IN THEIR TAIL WHILE ANYWHERE ON THE SHOW GROUNDS.** Weanlings are not considered stallions; only intact horses one year or older (as of January 1<sup>st</sup>) are considered stallions.

31. Any horse known to kick must wear a red ribbon in their tail at all times while on the show grounds. **These ribbons are not for decoration** – please use caution when approaching a horse with a red ribbon.

## APPROPRIATE DRESS

32. All riders/handlers are to dress according to the class in which they are entered and the style in which they show. That is, English attire with English tack and English way of moving; Western attire with Western tack and Western way of moving.  
Exception: A judge may require Western riders trot and post or that English riders sit the trot).
33. N Bar H welcomes all disciplines that show on the flat and over fences, including hunt seat, dressage, saddle seat and western. We ask that you understand that we get a variety of judges especially in the pleasure show, and a particular judge may not be expert in your specific style of showing. Should that be the case, please be open and use it as a great learning experience.
34. We highly encourage all riders to wear ASTM-SEI approved headgear at all times while mounted, regardless of discipline. A rider or handler will not be marked down in any class for wearing a helmet instead of a hat or derby regardless of age of rider or style of helmet.
35. All hunt seat and dressage riders as well as youth under 18 must wear ASTM-SEI approved headgear with harness secured and properly adjusted at all times when mounted, including at Gymkhana shows. Any rider violating this rule will be prohibited from riding until the appropriate headgear is in place, properly adjusted and fastened.
36. All riders in jumping classes must wear protective headgear that passes ASTM-SEI testing standards.
37. At the Gymkhana shows, formal show attire is not required. While Western tack is encouraged, any safe, non-abusive tack that allows a rider to adequately control the horse at the speed of travel is allowed. If show management deems your tack unsafe for your speed, you will be required to change tack in order to continue. Rider's footgear must have at least a 1-inch heel; no work boots or sneakers of any type (including riding sneakers) are allowed. We encourage ASTM-SEI helmets for everyone and require them for all riders under 18 years old whenever mounted.
38. Martingales, tie-downs, draw-reins, etc. are not permitted in any Pleasure show class.
39. N Bar H encourages the humane treatment of all equines and assumes that you will not use any severe equipment. Show management and judges reserve the right to determine if equipment is severe and what penalty will be imposed should it be found so.

## GENERAL CLASS RULES

40. The gate will close 2 minutes after the class is called to the ring. To hold the gate for a tack change, you must request a gate hold from the secretary's booth **TWO CLASSES BEFORE** the one you want held. The gate **WILL NOT** be held except in an emergency unless the request is made in advance. Feel free to let the secretary know all needed gate holds at the beginning of the day. The gate will be held for an additional 2 minutes only. If you are not in the arena by the time the gate closes, you will forfeit your class fee for that class.
41. Gymkhana riders must be at the gate and ready to enter the ring when called; we announce three people in advance, so you should always have plenty of time to get to the gate in a timely manner.

**NOTE:** If needed, you may ask **in advance** that certain horses be separated in order of call (i.e., you need to change tack and/or switch mounts). Please make sure you make any requests at least 2 classes in advance and we will do our very best to accommodate your needs. The best time to make these requests is always while you are registering – if pre-registering (and we hope you do), please feel free to just make a note on the form and we will gladly do our best to accommodate those needs.

42. Children riding leadline must show reasonable control of the horse at all times, both in and out of the show ring, while being led at the walk and trot/jog. Leaders must remain at the shoulder of the horse, may not speak except in an emergency, and must be at least 18 years old.
43. Hitting a horse in front of the girth is automatic disqualification and the rider may be asked to leave the grounds. This rule does not apply to English hunt bats or whips.
44. Each class will be run and pointed as long as there is at least one entrant.
45. If any competitor has special needs, please see show management; we will do our very best to accommodate you.
46. Riders/handlers of all disciplines are encouraged to participate in all classes, except where specifically segregated.
47. The show rules, as written, will remain in effect for the entire show season. Any change will take effect the following year's show season.

## **DIVISION DEFINITIONS**

### **PLEASURE: ALL DIVISIONS ARE OPEN TO ALL SEATS (DISCIPLINES)**

**Leadline** – 10 YEARS AND UNDER. Exhibitor to be lead by a handler 18 years of age or older. Rider must show reasonable control of mount. Handler must remain at the shoulder of the mount and must not aid the rider verbally or physically except in an emergency. Preference will be given to the rider who demonstrates control over their horse. The leadline is there only for safety purposes. Classes 1, 6, 7, 8, 20

**Walk/Trot:** The walk/trot divisions are for novice riders on seasoned horses OR non-beginner riders on green horses. Novice riders and green horses should not be cantering at other shows.

A-Division Walk/Trot – Rider is 8 years or under. Classes 1, 9, 10, 11, 21

B-Division Walk/Trot – Rider is 9 – 15 years old. Classes 1, 12, 13, 14, 22

C-Division Walk/Trot – Rider is 16 years or over. Classes 1, 15, 16, 17, 23

### **Beginner Rider/Green Horse – Open to all ages**

A Beginner Rider is a rider of any age who are new (1<sup>st</sup> or 2<sup>nd</sup> year) to cantering/loping. A Beginner rider may never use a Green Horse at N Bar H shows. The rider must move up out of this division once he/she wins two or more year-end awards.

A Green Horse is one new to showing (1st or 2nd year) at the canter in a group; no beginner riders may show green horses at N Bar H shows. Green horses may compete in either walk/trot or Green Horse, but not both. A horse must move up out of this division once he/she wins two or more year-end awards.

Classes 2 or 3, 24, 32, 33, 34

**Jr. – 15 Years and Under:** Rider is 15 years old or younger as of January 1<sup>st</sup> of the show year. Classes 2, 26, 35, 36, 37

**Sr. – 16 Years and Over:** Rider is 16 years old or older as of January 1<sup>st</sup> of the show year. Classes 3, 27, 38, 39, 40

**Driving:** Open to all ages. Driving horses, ponies, or miniatures are welcome. Classes 28, 29, 30, 31

**Hunter/Jumper:** Open to all ages. Classes 42, 43, 44

**In Hand:** Open to all ages and horses/ponies of all sizes. Classes 2 or 3, 4 or 5, 19, 25

### **MINIATURE HORSES:**

All divisions are specified in Class list by Handler Age or by horse size, sex, or color.

## **GYMKHANA:**

**Leadline:** Rider is 10 years old or younger; handlers must be at least 18 years old.

### **Novice Rider/Green Horse Jr. and Sr.:**

A Novice Rider is one who is new to riding and/or Gymkhana (gaming)

A Green Horse is one who is also new to either being ridden and/or Gymkhana

Jr.: Rider is 15 years old or younger as of January 1<sup>st</sup> of the show year.

Sr.: Rider is 16 years old or older as of January 1<sup>st</sup> of the show year.

NOTE: We ask you to self-regulate entry into these divisions. There are no gait restrictions as long as the rider maintains control of his/her horse. Rider or horse must move up out of this division once either receives 2 year-end awards.

**13 & Under:** Rider is 13 years old or younger as of January 1<sup>st</sup> of the show year.

**14-17:** Rider is at least 14 years old but no older than 17 years as of January 1<sup>st</sup> of show year.

**Adult:** Rider is at least 18 years old as of January 1<sup>st</sup> of the show year.

**Masters:** Adult riders 40 years or older as of January 1st who choose to run in slightly less competitively.

NOTE: Adult riders over 40 may choose to ride in either the Adult or Masters division. There are no gait or speed restrictions in the Masters division.

## PLEASURE HORSE CLASS DESCRIPTIONS

1. **Leadline & Walk Trot Fitting and Showmanship** - Open to all ages showing in the leadline or walk/trot divisions. Entries to be shown without a saddle. English horses may be shown in a bridle or halter, with no preference to either. Western horses must be shown in a halter. Halters must be appropriate to discipline: breed, nylon and leather halters are acceptable; only western handlers may use western - style halters. Class will be judged 50% on showmanship and 50% on grooming, conditioning and appointments of the horse and exhibitor. Exhibitors must dress in hat or helmet, boots and gloves appropriate for their age and discipline. May have someone 18 or over in the arena to aid. Exhibitor must show reasonable control of mount.
2. **Jr. Fitting and Showmanship** - See class 1
3. **Sr. Fitting and Showmanship** - See class 1
4. **Open Horse Halter** - Entries to be shown in hand with a suitable bridle or halter (see class 1). Breed not to count; may show according to breed standard. Will be required to move at the walk and trot or jog. To be judged on conformation and way of going.
5. **Open Pony Halter** - Open to all ponies under 14.2 hands and all Mini Horses. See class 4.
6. **Leadline Equitation**- To be shown at the walk and trot/jog. Class to be judged on rider's form. Proper seat, hands, and aids. Diagonals not to count, except in the case of a tie.
7. **Leadline Pleasure** - See class 6. Judged on manners, soundness and way of going.
8. **Leadline Challenge** - To be posted morning of show. Each month will be a different fun class.
9. **A-Div. Walk/Trot Equitation** - To be judged at the walk and trot/jog both ways of the arena. Judged on riders form, position, proper seat, hands and aids. Diagonals count.
10. **A-Div. Walk/Trot Pleasure** - See class 9. Judged on manners, soundness and way of going.
11. **A-Div. Walk/Trot Challenge** - See class 8.
12. **B-Div Walk/Trot Equitation** - See class 9.
13. **B-Div. Walk/Trot Pleasure** - See class 10.
14. **B-Div Walk/Trot Challenge** - See class 8.
15. **C-Div. Walk/Trot Equitation** - See class 9.
16. **C-Div. Walk/Trot Pleasure** - See class 10.
17. **C-Div. Walk/Trot Challenge** - See class 8
18. **Walk/Trot Equitation over cross rails** - Open to all walk/trot riders. And Beginner Canter/ Green Horse (but can not cross enter into open jumping classes) To be shown over a course of no less than 6 fences. Judged on the riders position, seat, hands, and aids over fences.
19. **Costume Open** - Open to any exhibitor and any number of horses and humans per entry. Entries to walk, drive or be led at the walk both ways of the arena. Helmets are required for all youth: anyone leading or walking beside a horse must wear closed toe, and hard heel shoes. Please control the safety of your costume for riding, driving or leading a horse. To be judged on originality and craftsmanship.

20. **Leadline Trail** - Entries to be shown at a walk and trot/jog over and through a pre-described course of obstacles similar to what you may find on a real trail. Horses may be asked to step over obstacles not exceeding 12" in height and go through narrow areas. Rider must show reasonable control of the mount and is responsible for knowing the course. The handler must be 18 or over and may not speak or obviously direct the horse or rider, points will be deducted from the rider's score. The handler may move out to the front of the horse to negotiate narrow areas or around an obstacle, but the rider is responsible for moving through the course in the correct order and at the correct gait.
21. **A-Div. Walk/Trot Trail** - Open to all walk/trot riders. Entries to be shown at the walk and trot/jog over and through a pre-described course similar to what you may find on the trail. Horses may be asked to step over obstacles not exceeding 12" in height and go through narrow areas.
22. **B-Div. Walk/Trot** - See class 21
23. **C Div. Walk/Trot** - See class 21
24. **Beginner/Green Horse Trail Open** - See class 21. Horses may be asked to canter/lope.
25. **Trail In Hand** - Open to all ages horse or pony. See class 21.
26. **Jr. Trail** - See class 21. Horses may be asked to canter/lope.
27. **Sr. Trail** - See class 21. Horses may be asked to canter/lope.
28. **Driving Trail** - To be shown at a walk, trot and extended trot over a pre-described course of obstacles. To be judged on the horses manners and performance throughout the course.
29. **Driving Reinsmanship** - To be shown at the walk, collected trot and working trot both ways of the arena. May be asked to back (headers are allowed). Judged 75% on handling of reins and whip, control, posture and overall appearance of the driver and 25% on proper harnessing and hitching, condition of horse or pony harness and vehicle, and neatness of attire.
30. **Driving Pleasure** - See class 21. To be judged on the horses performance, soundness, manners, way of going and suitability as a pleasure driving horse.
31. **Driving Challenge Open** - See class 34
32. **Beginner rider/Green Horse Equitation** - For Riders beginning to canter/lope and green horses. No beginner riders on green horses. To be shown at a walk, trot/jog, and canter/lope both ways of the arena. No more than 4 horses to canter/lope at once. Judged on riders seat, hands, position, and aids.
33. **Beginner rider/Green Horse Pleasure** - See class 22. To be judged on horse's manner, soundness, and way of going. May be asked to back.
34. **Beginner rider/Green Horse Challenge** - To be posted morning of show. Each month will be a different fun class.

42. **Hunter Under Saddle Open** - To be shown at the walk, trot, canter, hand gallop both ways of the arena. Extended trot may be asked by the judge. Judged on suitability of the horse for this style of riding, manner, control, and smoothness of the performance on the flat.
43. **Equitation Over Fences Open** - Course of no less than 6 jumps, not to exceed 2'3". Judged on rider's seat, hands, position, and aids.
44. **Hunter Over Fences** - Course of no less than 6 jumps, not to exceed 2'3". To be judged on the horse's manners, soundness, and way of going over fences.
45. **Sit-A-Buck** - non pointed, no entry fee. Bring your own \$1.00.

## MINIATURE HORSE CLASS DESCRIPTIONS

Any miniature horse 34" and under is considered an "A".

Any miniature horse over 34" and up to 38" is considered a "B".

The horse may only be entered into classes in its own division. Handlers may show more than one horse in performance classes except driving, but the same horse may only be shown once. Halter classes are split by horse division, and are only open to that division based on the horse's size, sex or color.

All other classes are split by handler age (as of January 1st) and are open to any miniature horse or miniature donkey. Miniature donkeys will be allowed to show in all performance classes. Preference will not be given to either miniature horses or donkeys. Classes will be judged 100% on the performance of the animal. In halter classes, if and only if all aspects are equal, preference will be given to the smaller animal.

1. **Showmanship, 15 and Over** will be judged 50% on showmanship, 40% on conditioning and grooming, and 10% on appearance and appointments of exhibitor. Hat and gloves required. Showmanship classes will use the quarter system. AMHA pattern 1, 2, or 3 will be chosen by the judge. Patterns and quarter system explanation and diagram can be viewed on Miniature Horse Showmanship Insert.
2. **Showmanship, 9-14** see class 1
3. **Showmanship, 8 and Under** see class 1; this division will only use pattern 1.
4. **Halter A Stallions & Geldings** To be shown at the walk and trot both ways around the ring. Judged on conformation, soundness, and way of going.
5. **Halter A mares** see class 4
6. **Halter B Stallions, Mares and Geldings** see class 4. May be divided if entries warrant.
7. **Youth Halter, 12 and Under** see class 4; open to exhibitor age 12 and under as of Jan. 1<sup>st</sup>.
8. **Junior Halter Horses 2 and Under** see class 4. Open to any horse foaled in current year or 2 previous years.
9. **Multicolor A and B** Open to Pinto, Appaloosa, and Pintaloosas. Horses will walk, all together, both ways of the ring. Horses will not be judged individually. Judged 100% on color.
10. **Solid Color A and B** See class 10. Open to all colors except Pinto, Appaloosa and Pintaloosas.
11. **Liberty 15 and Over** Horses will be judged on style, grace, animation, gaits, presence, suitability of music to horse's movements and ease of catching. Each exhibitor will have 1 minute to show. As soon as the music starts the exhibitor removes the halter and lets the horse go. One helper is allowed in the ring with exhibitor. The exhibitor and helper may use aids (shakers, whips) to excite the horse but may not touch the horse with any aid. Touching the horse will be cause for disqualification. At the end of one minute the music will stop and the exhibitor (not the helper) must catch the horse. They have one minute to do so No baiting is allowed during the class, or during the catching of the horse. If the horse is not caught in one minute the show manager will give the exhibitor a bucket of grain so that the horse can be caught quickly.

## 11. Liberty 15 and Over (Cont'd)

**NO horse that is not caught in the one minute time limit shall place higher than a horse who is caught within time, regardless of other factors.** Class to be judged 60% on animation and style 20% on gaits, 10% on music and suitability and 10% on ease of catching. Each exhibitor is limited to one entry in this class; however an exhibitor may enter the ring again as a helper. Exhibitors **MUST** turn their music in to the show booth by 8a.m. This will be strictly enforced, only those who turn their music in by 8:00 a.m. will be allowed to compete.

**12. Liberty 14 and Under** see class 12 exhibitors must be under 15 as of Jan 1<sup>st</sup>

**13. Driving** To be shown at the walk, collected trot and working trot both ways of the ring. Will be asked to back (headers are allowed). Judged 100% on the horse's performance, soundness, manners, way of going and suitability as a pleasure driving horse. **Excessive speed will be penalized.** Class will be divided if 12 or more entries.

**14. Driving Challenge** To be shown at the walk, collected trot and working trot both ways of the ring. Will be asked to back (headers are allowed). Judged 100% on the horse's performance, soundness, manners, way of going and suitability as a pleasure driving horse. **Excessive speed will be penalized.** Class will be divided if 12 or more entries.

**15. Leadline (Up to six years, Under 50 lbs)** exhibitor to be led by handler 18 years or older. Rider must show reasonable control of mount. Handler must remain at the horse's shoulder and must not aid the rider verbally or physically except in an emergency. Preference will be given to the riders who demonstrate independent control of their horse. The lead line is there for safety purposes only. To be shown at walk and trot/jog.

**16. Costume** to be shown at the walk both ways around ring. Judged on creativity, originality and presentation.

**17. Trail, Masters (40 & Up).** To be shown over a pre-described course of obstacles. Horses will be asked to walk, trot, back walk through or over obstacles, halt, drape something over their backs, side-step and jump (not over 12"). Other creative obstacles may be added. Going over or through the obstacles with your horse is permitted, but if performance is equal, preference will be given to the horse that performs independently (handler goes around obstacle). Handlers must be over 40 years of age.

**18. Trail, 18 – 39** see class 17

**19. Trail, 13-17** see class 17

**20. Trail, 9-12** see class 17

**21. Trail, 8 and Under** see class 17

**22. Open Hunter, Masters** Hunter classes will be judged on style, form, manners and way of going over a course of no less than 6 jumps. Preference will be given to those horses that cover the course at an even pace, with free flowing strides, as a brisk trot or canter, but must maintain the same gait throughout the course. Changing gates, rushing fences, touches, refusals, and knockdowns will be penalized. Exhibitors will be eliminated after 3 refusals. While N Bar H does permit exhibitors to jump with the horse, favor will be given to those horses that can jump independently. Because this is judged as a hunter class, judging for the overall picture considering the above factors. It is subjective and there is no specific number of faults or penalties. Jumps for Hunter 13 and over shall be between 18" and 24".

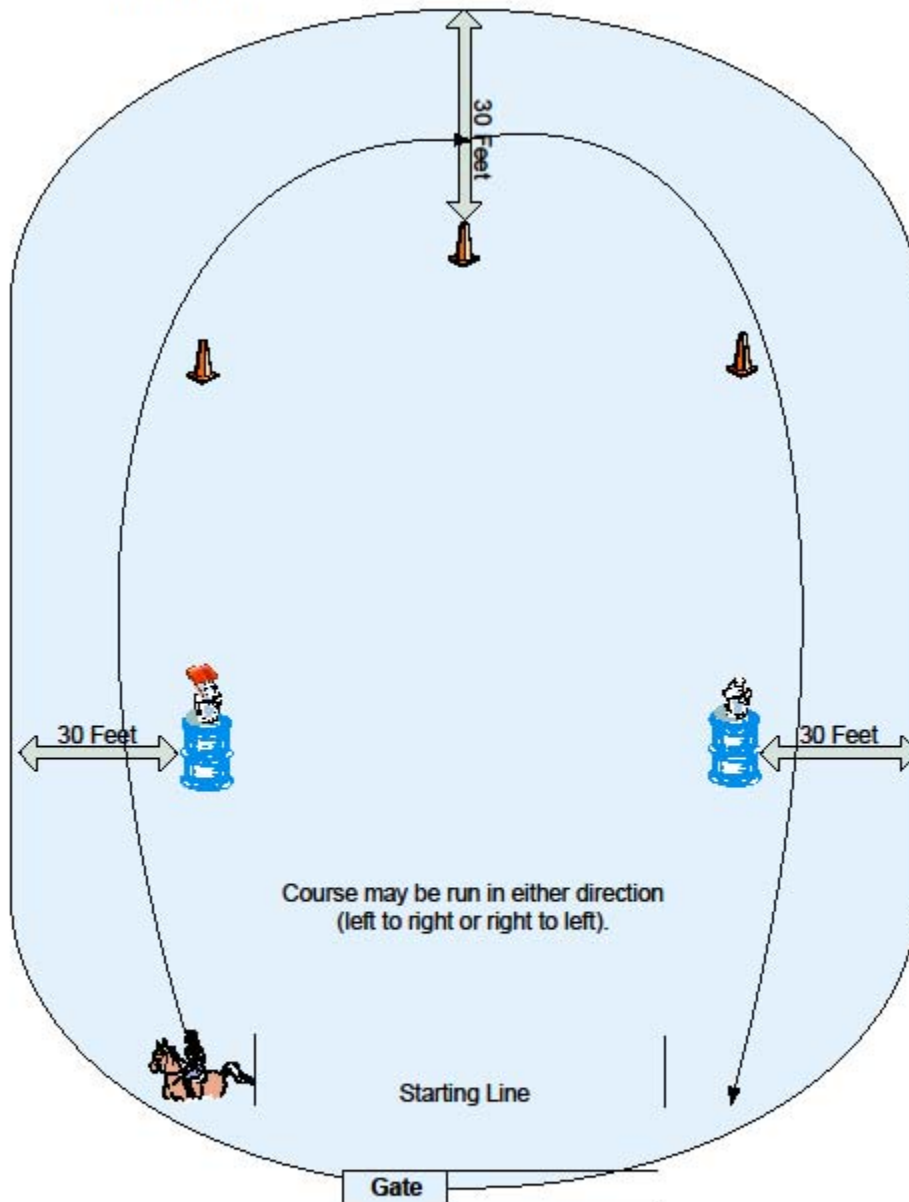

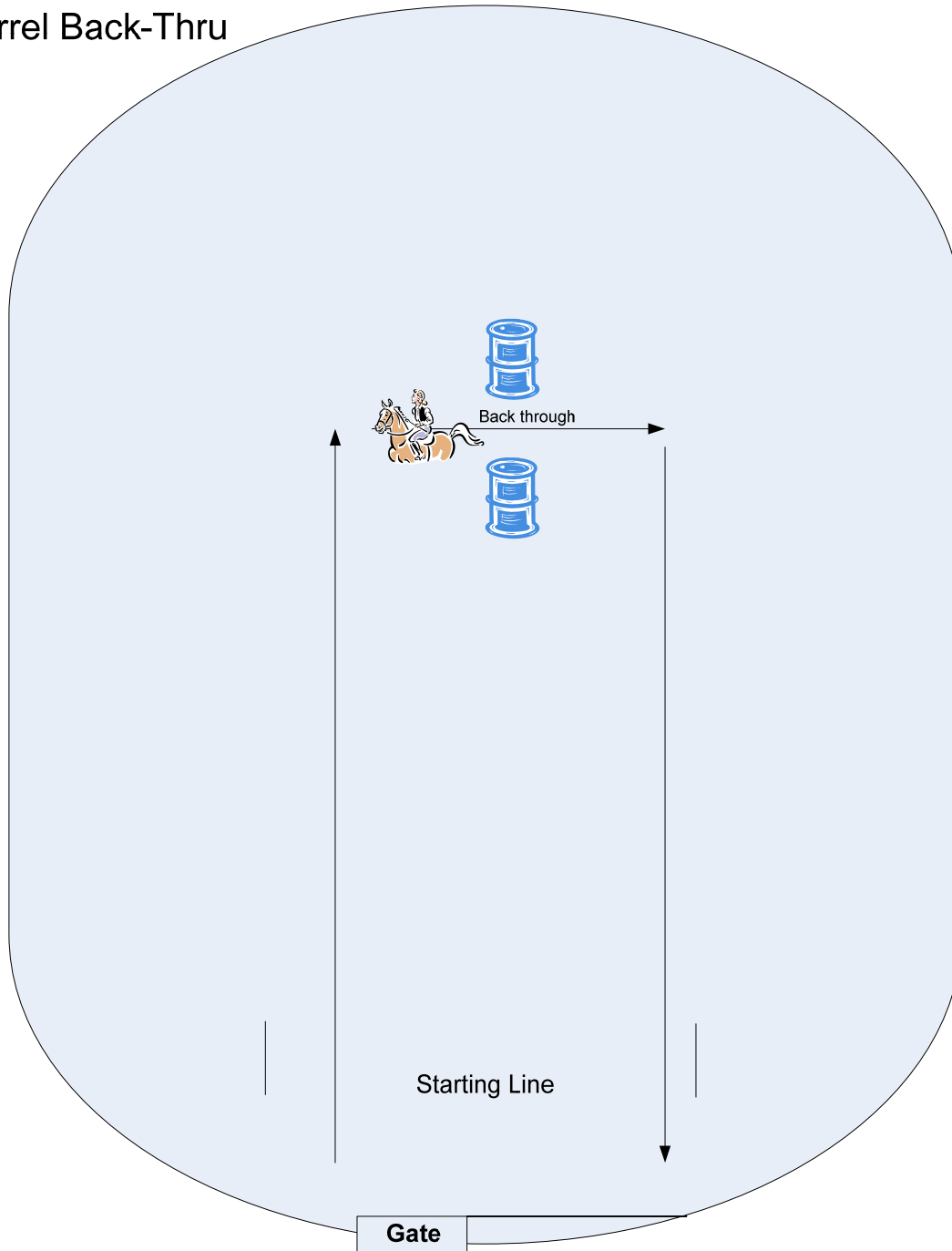
## FLAG RACE



Rider begins at Starting Line, and rides along the rail and takes the flag from the bucket on top of the barrel. Rider then continues to ride along the rail and deposits flag into the bucket on top of the 2<sup>nd</sup> barrel.

Knocking over the barrel, dropping the flag, falling from the horse, or failing to stay on the rail side (outside the barrels and cones) disqualifies run. For this class, the rider does not need to go through the starting poles. Fastest qualified run wins.

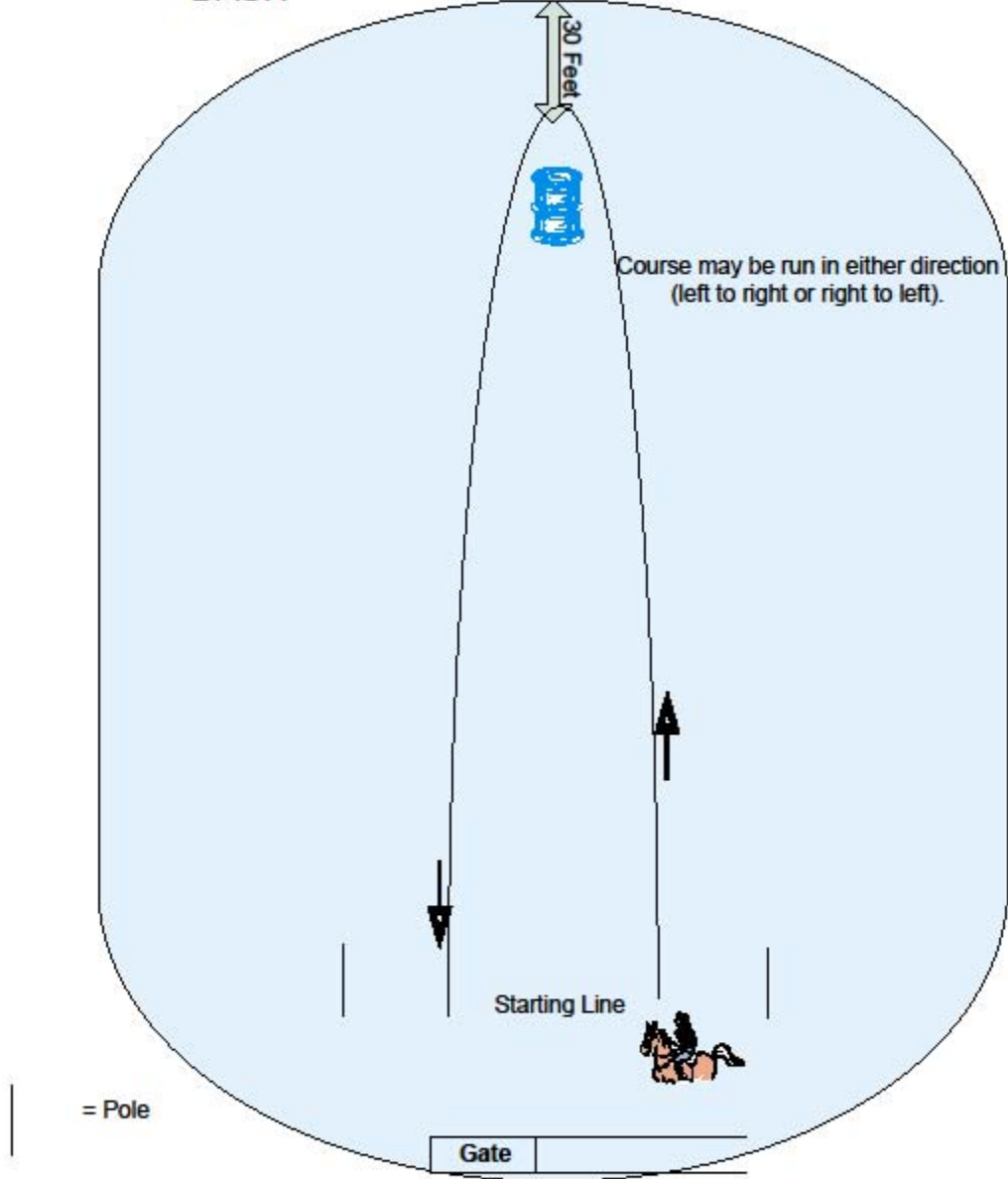
## Barrel Back-Thru

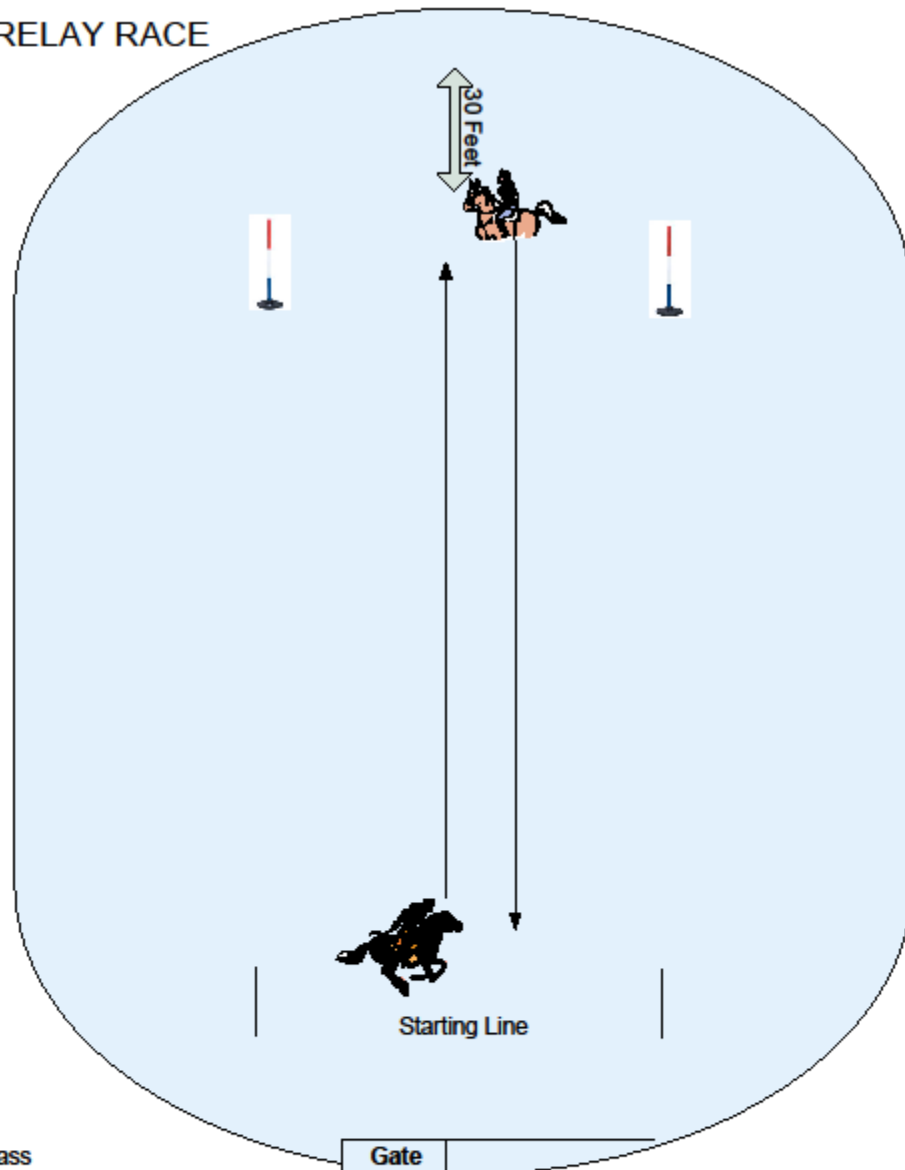

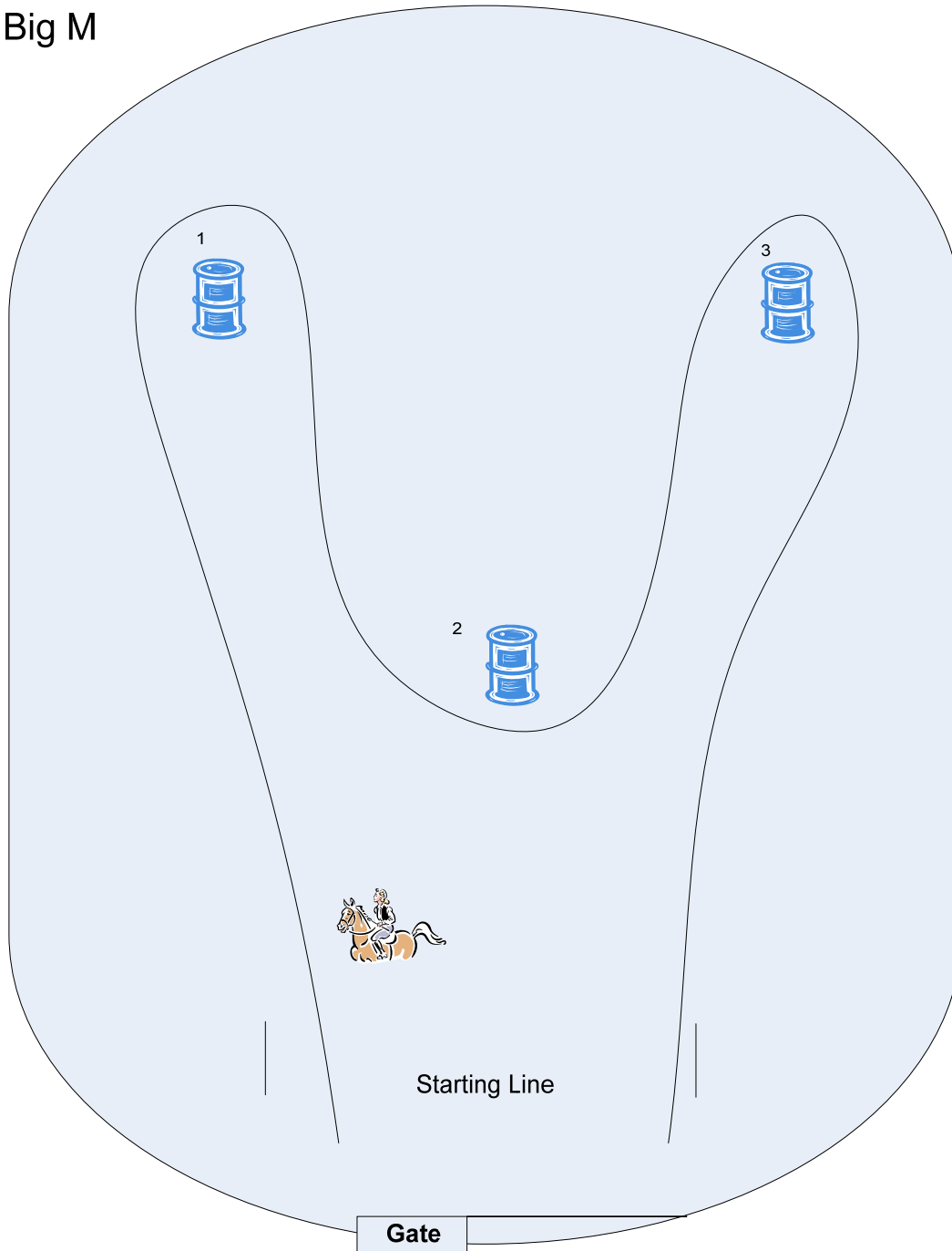
Pairs Class

Rider 1 begins at Starting Line, Rider 2 must wait behind the poles set at the far end of the arena. Rider 1 rides up, hands a baton or flag to Rider 2 and Rider 2 now races back to the finishing line with the baton/flag; Rider 1 must now keep his/her horse behind the poles until Rider 2 has completed the run.

One horse must be behind the poles at all times; knocking over a pole, falling from the horse, or having both horses across the pole line disqualifies the run.

Time begins when Horse 1 crosses starting line and ends when Horse 2 crosses the finishing line. Fastest qualified run wins.

## Big M

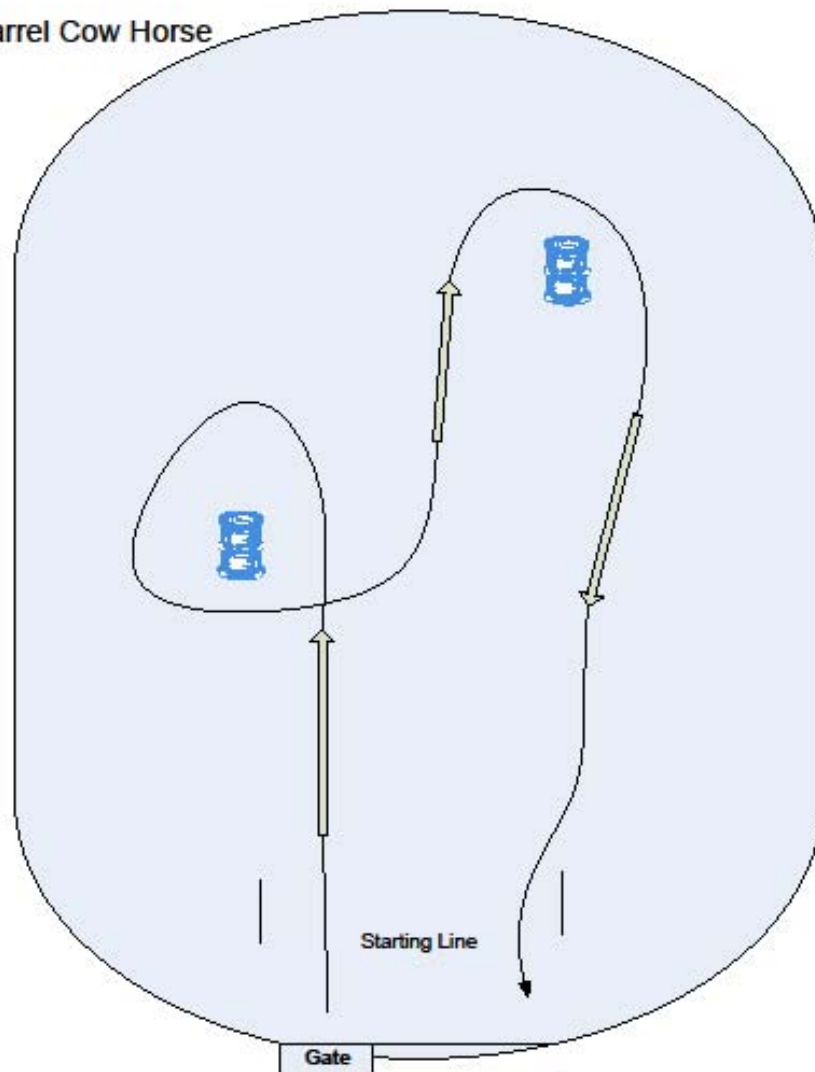


Rider begins at Starting Line and runs to the outside of barrel 1, takes a right turn around barrel 1 and heads back to barrel 2, takes a left turn around barrel 2 and heads for barrel 3. 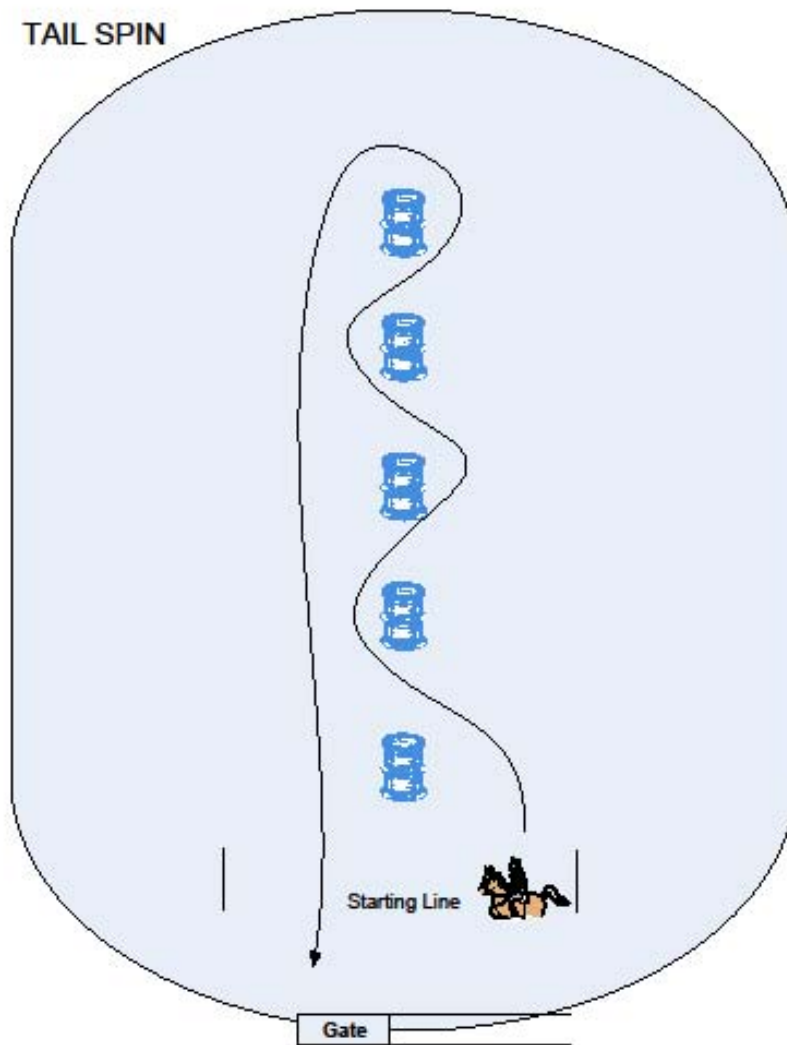

## TAIL SPIN

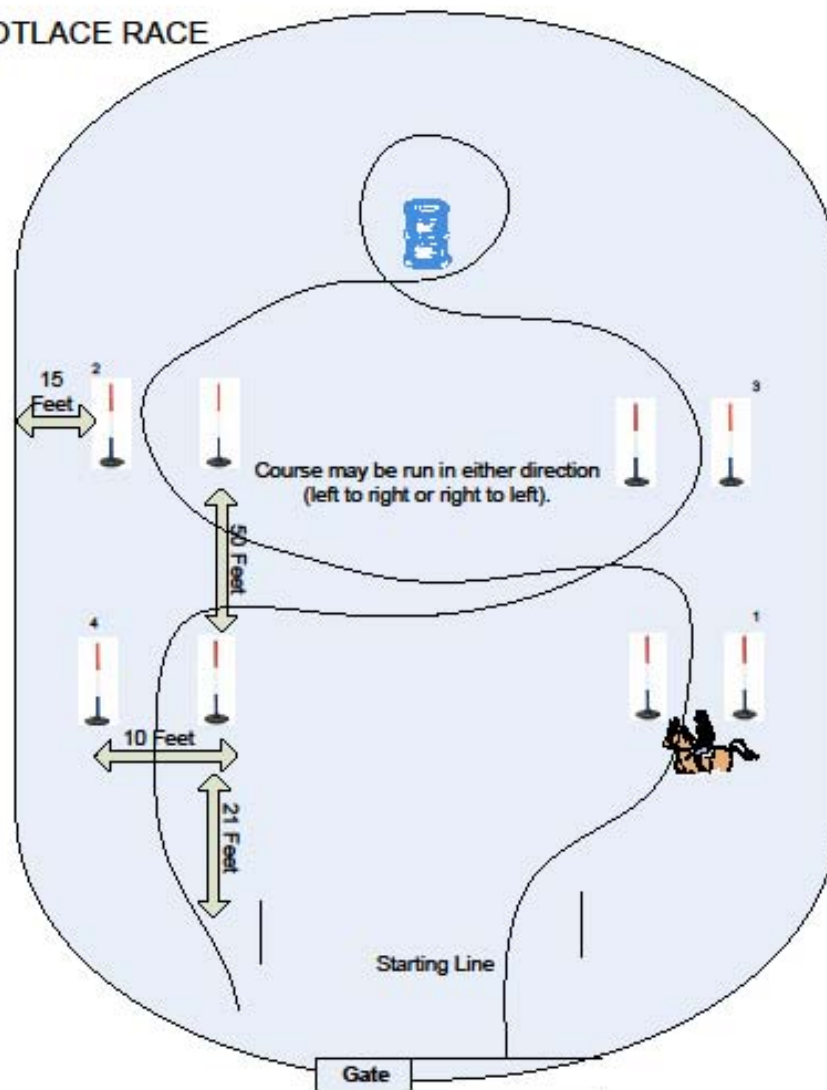


Rider begins at Starting Line and weaves up between five barrels. Course can begin to the right or left.

Knocking over a barrel, falling from the horse, or breaking pattern and failing to weave between two of the barrels disqualifies the run.

## BOOTLACE RACE



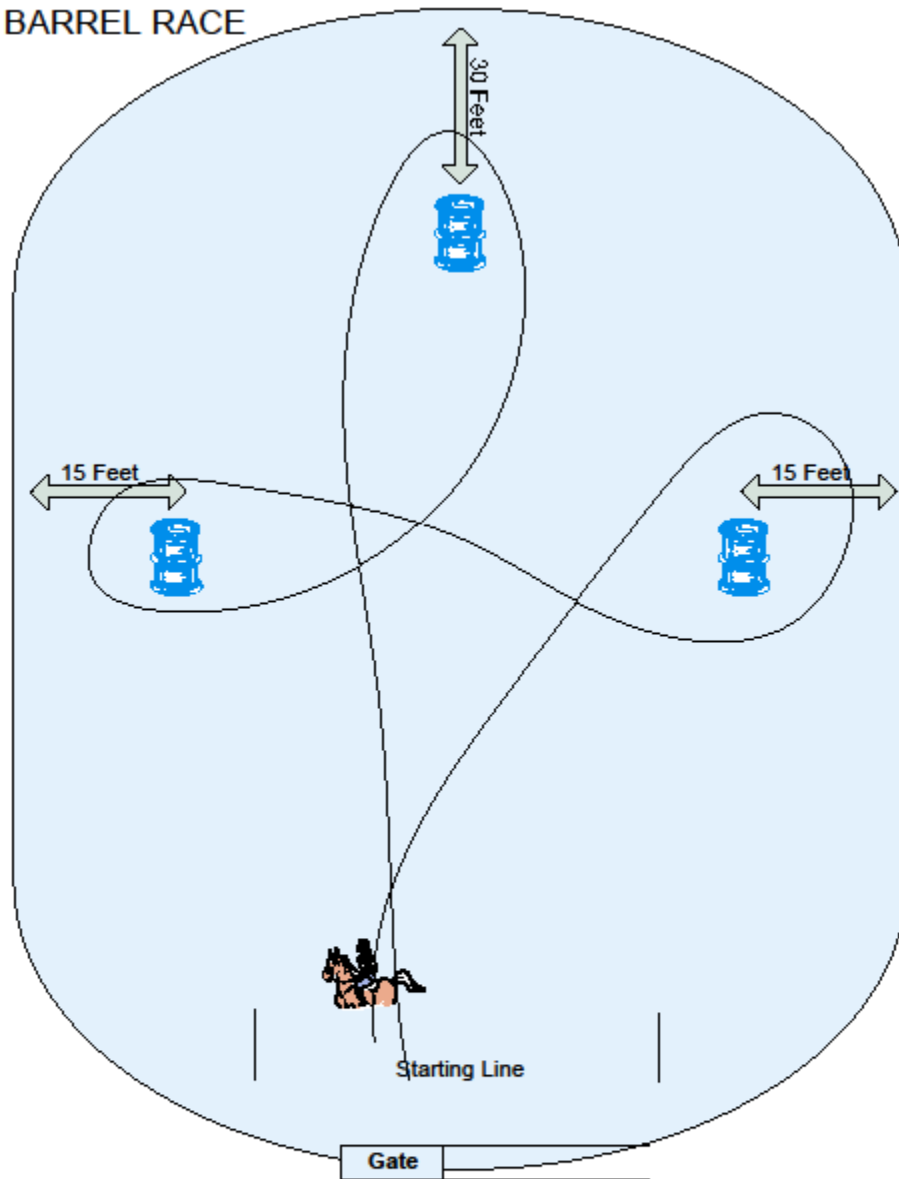
Rider begins at Starting Line, and rides between the poles following 1 of 2 patterns, either 1, 2, circle barrel to the left, 3, and 4 or alternately, 4, 3, circle barrel to the right, 2, and 1 then races across the start/finish line.

While the starting poles will be left in the arena for this class (to show where the timer line is), rider may choose to use or not use them, there will be no penalty either way.

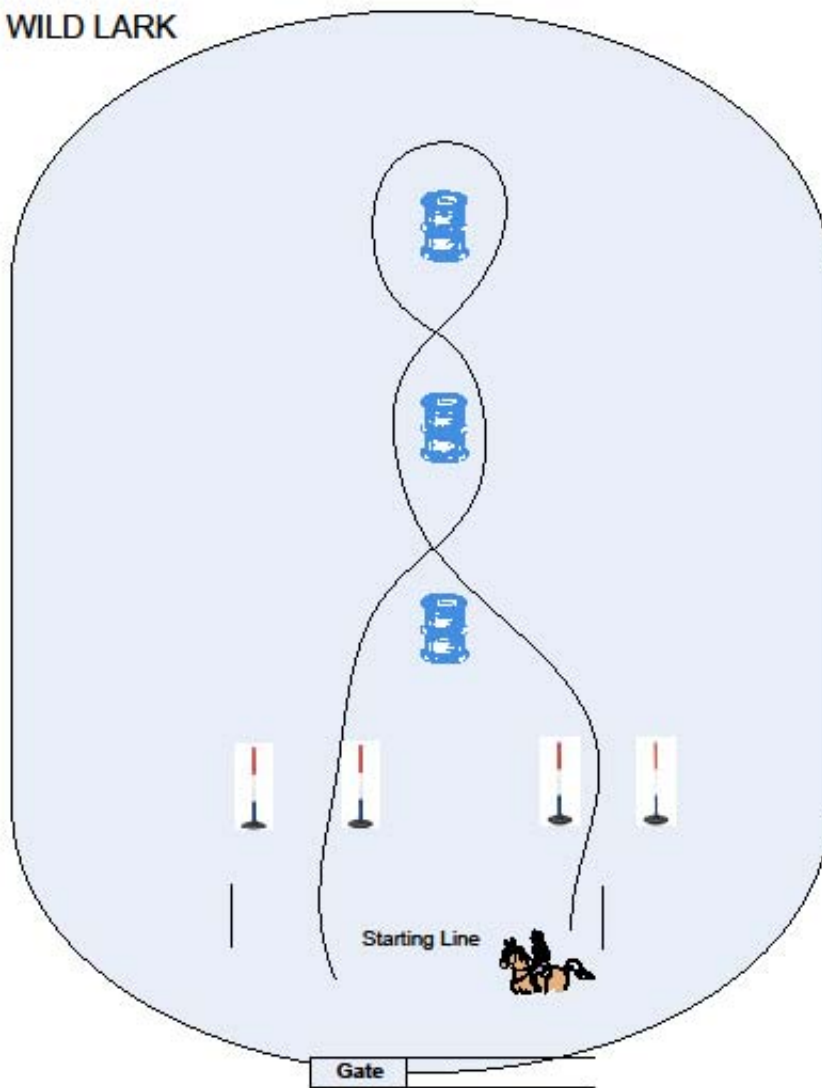

## WILD LARK

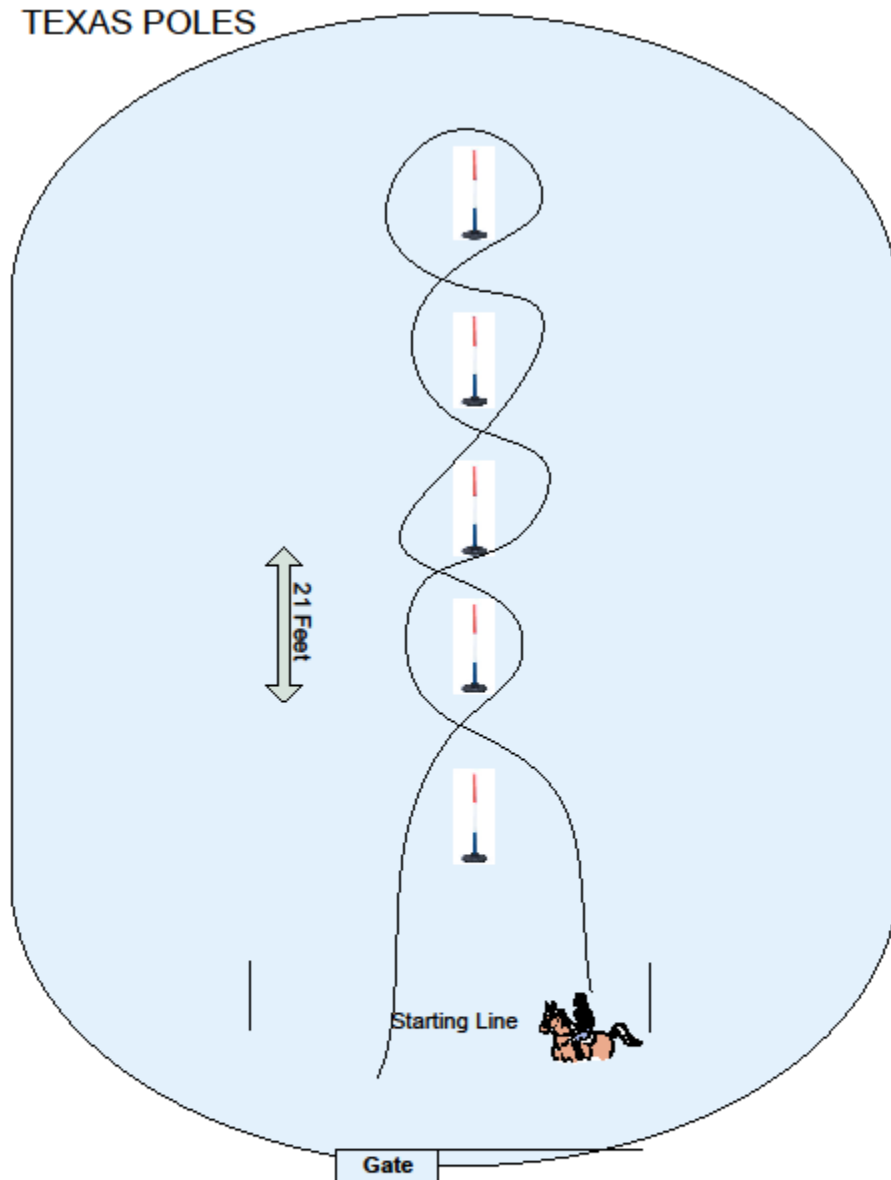


Beginning at start line, rider/horse runs between start poles then between either right or left pair of poles, weaves the three barrels up and back, finishing by running between the opposite set of poles and crossing the finish line between the start poles.

Knocking over a pole or barrel, falling from the horse, or breaking the pattern disqualifies the run.

Fastest qualified run wins.

## TEXAS POLES



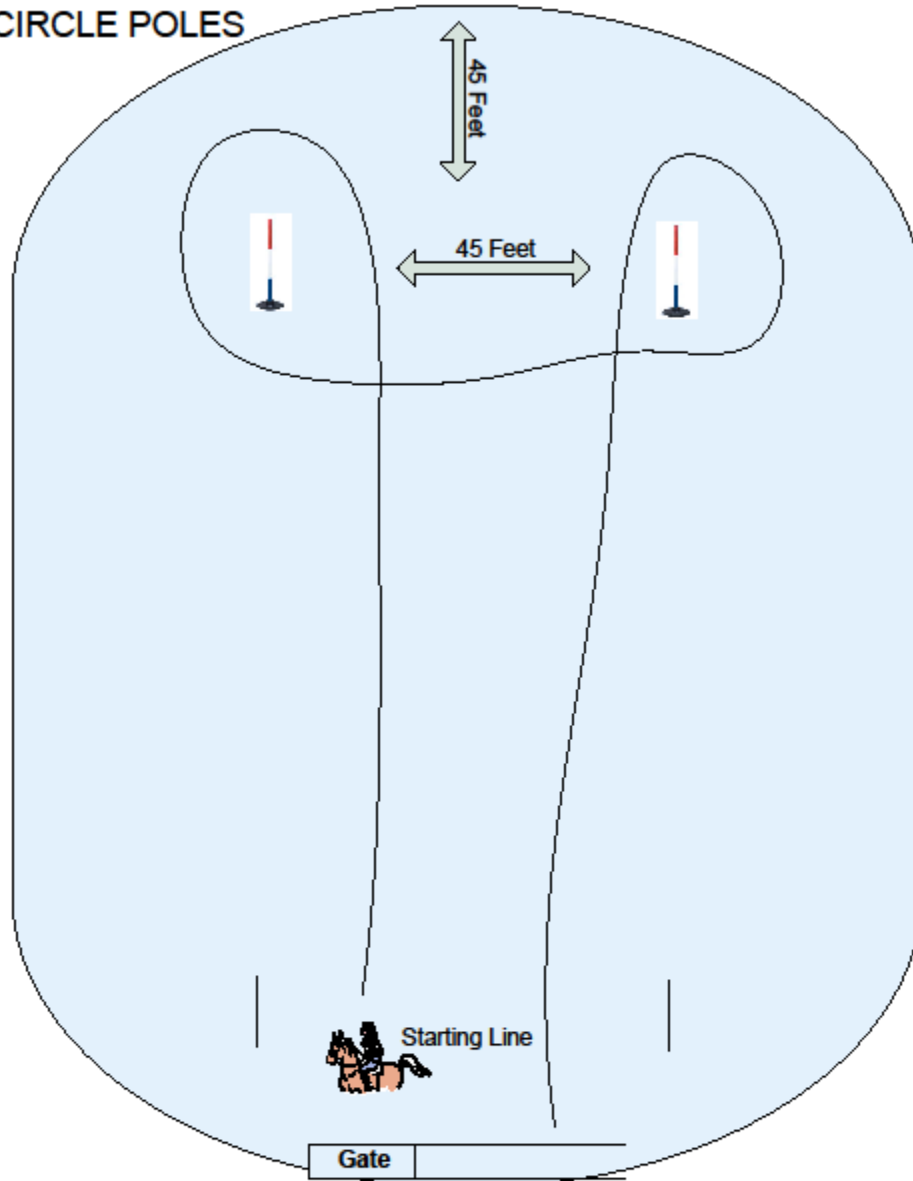
Rider begins at Starting Line and weaves up and back between five poles. Course can begin to the right or left.

## CIRCLE POLES



Rider begins at Starting Line, and rides between the poles, making a left hand turn around the first pole, rides straight across to the second pole, makes a left hand turn around the second pole and runs home.

Knocking over a pole, falling from the horse, or breaking the pattern disqualifies the run.
